Will Legal Aid pay for my lawyer?

Check the table to the right to see if you qualify for legal aid. If you qualify, we will help pay for a lawyer to represent you. The lawyer has to do legal aid work.

If you are experiencing domestic abuse, please let us know when you apply because we have special services.

Note: We may ask you to pay for some of your fees. When you **apply**, we will talk to you about this more. We will also ask you about any assets you have such as any money in your savings account, investments, or property etc.
