BILINGUAL LEGAL COUNSEL

The **Human Rights Legal Support Centre (HRLSC)** provides a broad range of free legal assistance to individuals throughout Ontario who have experienced discrimination contrary to Ontario's *Human Rights Code*. The HRLSC is seeking applications for a **Legal Counsel – Bilingual** position to provide legal services and representation to HRLSC clients including at mediations and hearings before the Human Rights Tribunal of Ontario (HRTO). Qualifications include human rights expertise, knowledge and familiarity with legal issues, including discrimination, and the ability to litigate before administrative tribunals in both English and French. Some travel may be required.

This is a full-time, permanent position. This position will form part of an OPSEU Bargaining Unit. This position currently offers a hybrid work schedule, requiring a combination of in-person work from the HRLSC's Toronto head office and remote work from home, each week. This arrangement may be subject to change as part of the HRLSC's Recovery Plan process. The HRLSC provides a competitive total compensation package. Salary for this position is **\$74,400+**. The usual hours of work are 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. **Bilingualism (English and French) is required.**
