### **Block Fee Case Categories & Processes**

| Summary II | Includes all Crown-option offences where the Crown proceeds summarily and the maximum penalty is greater than six months   | <ul> <li>Assault causing bodily harm or with a weapon</li> <li>Threatening death or bodily harm</li> <li>Breach of probation</li> <li>Cruelty to animals</li> </ul> |
| Indictable | Includes all offences and Crown-option offences (except<br>excluded charges) where the Crown proceeds by way of<br>indictment<br>Gambling offences   |   |
| Excluded   | Very serious criminal charges or offences such as murder,<br>terrorism offences, etc are excluded.<br>• paid under hourly tariff; <u>not</u> part of the block fee program                   | <ul> <li>Murder – first and second degree</li> <li>Kidnapping</li> <li>Child pornography offences</li> <li>Arson</li> </ul>   |
|            | Certain cases and processes are excluded from block fees   | <ul> <li>YCJA cases</li> <li>BCM / CCR cases</li> <li>Miscarriage of justice reviews</li> <li>Appeals</li> </ul>  |

| Resolution<br>Block  | Guilty Pleas    | Fee is inclusive of preparations, attendances, etc., in<br>event case is resolved by guilty plea of one or all charges<br>prior to matter being set down for trial                     |
|  | Stay/Withdrawal | <ul> <li>Fee is inclusive of preparations, attendances etc., in<br/>event case is resolved by withdrawal of one or all charges<br/>prior to matter being set down for trial</li> </ul> |
