Some of the ways we help

If you are in Ontario and qualify for legal aid these are *some* of the services that we will provide or pay a lawyer to:

- Give you up to three hours of free immigration advice.
- Help you with your refugee claim, including your Basis of Claim (BOC) form.
- Help you appeal an immigration decision.
- Complete an application for you to stay in Canada on Humanitarian and Compassionate (H&C) grounds.
- Help you if the government wants to take away your status as a refugee or permanent resident.

Check this table to see if you qualify financially.

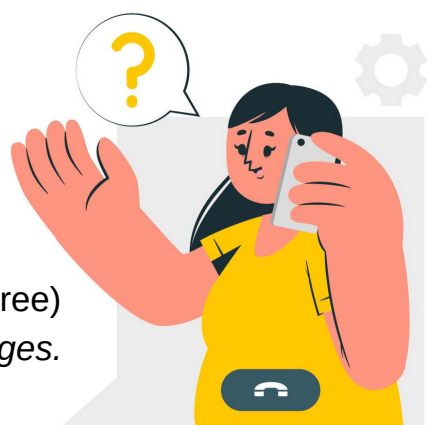
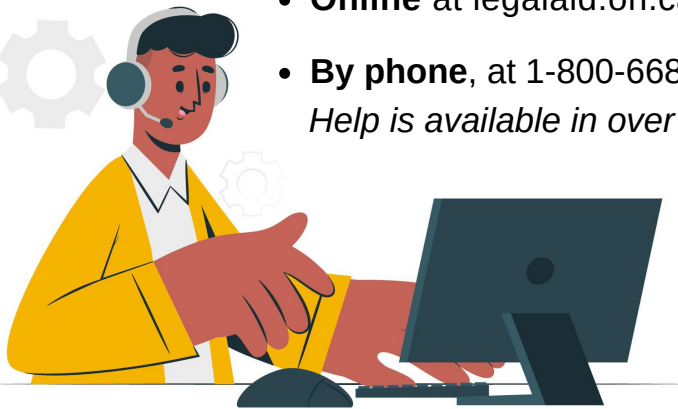
Income is one of the factors used to determine whether you qualify financially. Property and savings are also considered.
