1. Introduction

In response to feedback from roster members who either work from home or on a hybrid basis, Legal Aid Ontario (LAO) launched a new functionality through which roster members will now easily be able to show or hide their addresses through the lawyer portal, <u>Legal Aid Online</u>.

2. Using the show and hide address function

If a roster member wants to use the show and hide address function, they can:

- Log into their Legal Aid Online Profile
- Navigate to the "Personal Info" tab
- Click on "Address Change"

- Wait 24 hours to ensure the change is reflected in the system

It is possible to schedule a future address change, which automatically occurs at a future date. If you schedule a future address change, you will need to log in to the portal after the address change takes effect to withhold your new address.
