	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> First return date of a status review Family Responsibility Office matters, e.g., first appearances, refraining motions, adjournments. First appearance / intake court First judicial case conference for applications, responses, motions to change. Second case conferences CYFSA matters in locations where clients are unable to retain counsel in a timely basis. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Duty counsel may assist with written consents, if negotiations have been completed and the issues are eligible for duty counsel service.
